Board of Commissioners of Converse County

The regular meeting was called to order on April 15, 2008 at 8:30 a.m. Present were Chair Jim Willox, Vice-Chair Ed Werner, Commissioner Mark Cash and County Clerk Lucile Taylor.

The Commission will pursue Workers' Compensation coverage that will be based on hazardous and/or clerical classifications for all County employees.

Mr. Cash moved to approve the Laird Subdivision on the outskirts of Glenrock as submitted at a public hearing on March 5, 2008. Mr. Werner seconded, motion carried.

Mr. Werner moved to approve the minutes of the regular meeting on April 1 and 2; special meetings on April 8 and April 10, 2008; reinstate warrant 26586 Douglas Budget \$498 and to void warrant 27242 WYDOT \$26,642.12. Mr. Cash seconded, motion carried.

The regular meeting recessed into a public hearing at 11:00 a.m. to obtain citizens' comments on the proposed renaming of a portion of Old Fort Fetterman Road (CR #16).

Public comments: None. The public hearing adjourned and the regular meeting reconvened at 11:05 a.m. The County will prepare a resolution for documentation and recording on the renamed portion as specified.

Mr. Werner moved to acknowledge the merger by and between Pacific Energy Partners, LP and Plains All American Pipeline, LP. Mr. Cash seconded, motion carried.
