

Board of Commissioners of Converse County

The regular meeting was called to order on May 1, 2007 at 8:00 a.m. Present were Chair Jim Willox, Vice-Chair Ed Werner, Member Mark Cash and County Clerk Lucile Taylor.

Other residents discussed possible solutions in trying to allow Mead and Davison access if the County Road was relocated at that portion. The County proposed relocating the CR through a public hearing and then keep the old portion as a public road to allow access for Mead and Davison. Mr. Olsen will visit with Mr. Mead about helping to mutually solve access for all residents and still get rid of the dangerous section.

The regular meeting recessed at 5:00 p.m. and reconvened at 8:07 a.m. on May 2, 2007. Chairman Jim Willox was excused.

The regular meeting recessed into a public hearing to obtain citizens' comments on the proposed Pierce Subdivision located at the NW¹/₄NW¹/₄ of Sec. 32, T32N, R71W of the 6th P.M., Converse County. The Planning and Zoning Commission recommended approval of the subdivision. There were no comments from the public.

Mr. Cash moved to re-appoint Mr. Terry Rider to a three-year term on the Northeast Wy Economic Development Council. Seconded by Mr. Werner. Motion carried.
