

# ABSENTEE VOTING

To qualify for an absentee ballot, you must be a registered voter in **Converse County**.

Absentee Ballots will be available July 8 – August 16, 2004, (40 days prior to the election.)

Voters may apply for an absentee ballot in one of the following ways:

- ❑ **By Mail** -You can print the application form from this website. Complete the form and mail it to the Converse County Clerk's Office.
- ❑ **By Telephone** - You may call the County Clerk's Office at (307) 358-2244.
- ❑ **In Person** -Complete the absentee ballot request form and bring into the County Clerk's Office located at the Courthouse, **107 North 5<sup>th</sup> Street, Suite 114, Douglas, WY 82633**. We are open 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Friday. Once you turn in the completed ballot request form, you are then eligible to receive a ballot. You may cast your ballot at the courthouse or take it with you.
- ❑ **Military Absentee Request** – (*Availability to Military ONLY*) Registration through the Federal Postcard Application (FPCA) constitutes temporary registration for the current election year only. The FPCA forms are available at your military bases.

**VOTED ABSENTEE BALLOTS MUST BE RECEIVED IN THE COUNTY CLERK'S OFFICE IN DOUGLAS BY 7:00 P.M. ON ELECTION DAY IN ORDER TO BE COUNTED. *THEY WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED AT ANY POLLING PLACE.***

**I requested and received an absentee ballot, but I have decided I want to vote at the polls. What do I do with the absentee ballot?** Take the unvoted absentee ballot in its Mailing Envelope, along with all other information you receive and give it to an Election Judge Official. You will then be issued a ballot at the polls on Election Day.
