

**RESOLUTION NO. 07-12
CONVERSE COUNTY, WYOMING**

**A RESOLUTION FOR THE PURPOSE OF ESTABLISHING NOTICE
OF REQUIREMENTS FOR MINERAL, OIL, AND GAS EXTRACTION**

WHEREAS, pursuant to W.S. §§ 18-5-102 and 18-5-201, the Converse County Board of Commissioners has the authority to regulate and restrict the location and use of buildings and structures, and the use, condition of use, or occupancy of lands within the unincorporated areas of Converse County, and desires to exercise such authority; and,

WHEREAS, to promote and protect the public health, safety, and general welfare of its citizens; and,

WHEREAS, mineral, oil, and gas activities are increasing in Converse County; and,

WHEREAS, Converse County will be responsible for protecting the citizens of Converse County while these activities are occurring; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

1. Prior to the significant construction or expansion of mineral, oil or gas extraction facilities, the owner/operator must provide notice of operations to the Converse County Commissioners.

2. Applicant must provide the following information and meet the following requirements:


A. Complete the Industrial Activity Form provided by Converse County requiring general administrative information and basic information on the proposed project.


B. Schedule and meet with the Converse County Commissioners to discuss the proposed project; and provide periodic updates therefore.


C. If directed by the County, negotiate a road use agreement with the Converse County Commissioners.




