

RESOLUTION NO. 03 - 17
CONVERSE COUNTY, STATE OF WYOMING

WHEREAS, effective July 1, 2017, the Board of County Commissioners is required pursuant to Wyo. Stat. § 12-5-10 I (d) to set hours of operation for alcohol sales in the unincorporated areas of Converse County, provided that the hours of operation are uniformly applied to establishments similarly situated; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Wyo. Stat. §12-5-201 the Board of County Commissioners may regulate minors' presence in a licensed building.

NOW, THEREFORE, having duly met at a regular meeting and considered the matter, it is

RESOLVED, licensees may begin alcoholic or malt beverage sales in the licensed building at 6:00 a.m. and shall close the sale of both alcoholic and malt beverages promptly at the hour of 2:00 a.m. the following day. In addition, licensees shall clear the licensed building or all persons other than employees by 2:30 a.m.


IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED THAT, except as provided below, no licensee or agent, employee, server shall knowingly permit any person under the age of twenty-one (21) years to enter or remain in the licensed building with the following exceptions:

- 1) Those establishments holding a restaurant license, limited retail licenses (clubs, guest ranch, golf course), resort license, catering permits are exempt from age restrictions as to presence of minors on the licensed premises.
- 2) If a retail license holder or bar/grill license holder operates a commercial kitchen or leases space for a commercial kitchen to a third party, within the licensed building, persons under the age of twenty-one (21) years may enter or remain in the licensed building until the hour of 10:00 p.m., so long as they are accompanied by a parent, guardian, or spouse who is twenty-one (21) years of age.
- 3) Establishments that operate primarily for off-premise sales (package liquor) shall maintain a separate area for the sale of alcoholic or malt beverages and comply with Wyo. Stat. §12-6-101(c)(vi).

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED THAT, this Resolution repeals and replaces and any other resolutions previously passed pertaining to the hours of operation and restrictions upon licensed liquor establishments.
