

**RESOLUTION NO. 20-20  
OF CONVERSE COUNTY, WYOMING**

**A RESOLUTION VACATING AND ABANDONING A PORTION OF  
COUNTY ROAD 31, ROSS ROAD**

**WHEREAS**, the Board of County Commissioners, Converse County, Wyoming deems it to be in the public interest to abandon and vacate a portion of a county road in accordance with Sections 24-3-101 through 24-3-127, Wyoming Statutes, 1977, as amended, with the vacation described as follows:

**WHEREAS**, the road was established in 1909-1911 and the vacation and abandonment is generally described as follows:

Beginning at a point in Section 22, Township 40 North, Range 75 West, latitude 43.42500, longitude -105.84863, thence running northwesterly and terminating at the west line of Section 31, Township 41 North, Range 75 West, latitude 42.47532, longitude -105.92446, approximately 5.88 miles. The current right-of-way for Ross Road is 33 feet on each side when measured at right angles or radially from the surveyed road center line.

**WHEREAS**, the Board reserves the access rights of the area landowners, and of governmental agencies to retain access to this road for performing essential public services.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, the Board of County Commissioners, Converse County, Wyoming, has complied with the provisions of Section 24-3-101 et. seq., Wyoming Statutes, 1977, as amended to complete the vacation.


